This is just a recommendation for 2 full days of tours. This is also giving you a day before to get there and you can really leave at the end of your last tour. Remember tours are on the hour and take approximately 1 hour but you want to give yourself at least 2 hours at the distillery for shopping and tastings. The 2nd day can be a full day if you stop at all of them. I've marked the tours not to miss but I do recommend you stopping at most of them on day two and they are pretty close together for the most part.

Day Before Tour

Louisville

Downtown life you would want to stay near 4th Street Live which is their entertainment district. Embassy Suites, Hyatt Regency, Omni, Louisville Marriott, Courtyard by Marriott (2nd St.) Look for hotels near KFC Yum Center or 4th Street Live. If you get into town early a fun thing is Jim Beam Urban Stillhouse Tableside Cocktail Class 3:00, 5:00, 7:00pm. \$25. Call ahead. Half hour class and they teach you to make a Jim Beam drink which was good and fun. Right downtown is also the Evan Williams Experience which is supposed to be a good tour (open 11:00-5:30 \$15). Don't waste your time on the **Old Forester** tour also downtown. Doc Crow's Barbeque has excellent food. Against the Grain Brewery also great place to eat (fantastic dry rub wings) right by the baseball stadium, Angels Envy across the street (open 10:00-5:00). Great bar to hit if you don't want anything fancy was the 3rd Street Dive Bar (it is a diver bar, but fun), mostly locals, a lot of fun when we were there otherwise 4th Street Live has multiple bars. The last trip we ate at Guy Fieri's Smokehouse on 4th St. and it was phenomenal, great sandwiches and the meatloaf WOW!!! Silver Dollar Bar has always been a place we've wanted to stop for drinks but have yet to make it. Sidebar on Whiskey Row, good bar. If you want to have a fancy drink go to the Seelbach Hilton Hotel for a nightcap.

The best place to buy regular not special bourbons in **Kroger's** all throughout Kentucky. They have much better prices than the distilleries. At the distilleries you may want to concentrate on only bourbons you can buy there or locally and not nationally distributed. Yes, it is cheaper at Kroger's than the distilleries.

Because of the closeness to the dates you will be at the mercy of the distilleries for tours so start contacting as soon as possible. You said you want to go the Buffalo Trace and the others. The decision you'll have to make is it's kind of like going to Elkhart and Michigan City whereas Buffalo Trace is in Michigan City and Bardstown is in Elkhart, It's possible but there is a distance between them, if this makes sense. I would say if you want to go to Buffalo Trace, you make it your first stop going down since on Sunday it opens later. As I explained they have their special allotment every day and they open at 9, but it's best to get there by 8. From Broad Ripple this is a 3 hour drive.

I will give a point rating for tours out of 5 for what I feel are the best tours and/or gift shop experiences. I recommend only 2 tours at the most each day but visit other distilleries in between
